



Guidelines for 2017 Paulding Education Foundation Scholarship

1. The amount to be awarded will be \$1,000.00 per Scholarship per Paulding County High School. One Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Senior at each High School. The Scholarships will be issued in accordance to the rules of the Scholarship Committee. The criteria for selection are as follows:
 - Must achieve a grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
 - Must be seeking a Bachelor's Degree or Equivalent.
 - Demonstrate involvement/contribution in the community.
 - Demonstrate financial need.
2. It is the responsibility of the applicant / recipient to furnish any needed information (acceptance letters and/or proof of enrollment) required for disbursements of scholarship funds. **All applications must be returned to your guidance counselor no later than March 31st, 2017.**
3. The Recipients shall be notified and awarded the Scholarships in May 2017. Special recognition and photo's will be in the local newspapers.
